Day 1 / Mar 3 – Hometown / Tokyo - Narita (Japan) (By Air)

Today, take your flight to Tokyo. Please inquire with your travel agent about the international air ticket.

Day 2 / Mar 4 – Arrive Tokyo

Cross the International Date Line to Japan. If flying Air Canada from Vancouver, you will be met at the airport and transferred to the hotel. If using other airlines, arrange your own airport limousine shuttle to the hotel at your expense.

Hotel: Hotel Metropolitan Ikebukuro or similar (4-Star)

Day 3 / Mar 5 – Tokyo

After breakfast, explore **Asakusa Kannon Temple** and enjoy city views from the **Tokyo Skytree Observation Deck**. Then, take a fun **Sushi-making Class for lunch** and visit the **Tokyo National Museum**, the **Imperial Palace East Garden**, and **Nijubashi Bridge**. Savor a **Yakiniku (Traditional Japanese-style BBQ) Welcome Dinner** in the evening. (B / SL / SD)

Day 4 / Mar 6 – Tokyo ~ Hakone ~ Mt. Fuji ~ Shizuoka

This morning, travel to Hakone for a scenic **boat cruise on Lake Ashi**, with views of Mt. Fuji on clear days. After a Tempura Soba lunch, drive to **Mt. Fuji 5th Station** for panoramic views and visit the serene **Shiraito Falls**. Return to the hotel after dinner. (B / L / D)

Day 5 / Mar 7 - Shizuoka ~ Nagoya

In the morning, take a 2.5-hour bus ride to Nagoya, visiting **Nagoya Castle** for a group photo and exploring **Atsuta Shrine**. Then, visit **Osu Kannon Temple** and wander **Osu Shopping Street** before lunch. In the afternoon, explore the **Toyota Commemorative Museum** and enjoy a **Sukiyaki (Japanese Hotpot) Dinner**. (B / L / SD)

Hotel: ANA Crowne Plaza Hotel Grand Court Nagoya or similar (4-Star)

Day 6 / Mar 8 - Nagoya ~ Kyoto

After breakfast, take a 2-hour bus ride to Kyoto and visit **Heian Shrine** and **Fushimi Inari Shrine**. Enjoy a **Ramen noodle lunch** and experience a **Traditional Tea Ceremony**, then explore the historic **Gion district** and **Hanami-koji Street**, where you might catch a glimpse of geikos or maikos. Dinner is at your arrangement. (B / L)

Day 7 / Mar 9 - Kyoto

This morning, explore the serene **Arashiyama Bamboo Grove** and **Togetsu Bridge**, then visit the stunning **Kinkakuji Temple (Golden Pavilion)**. After lunch, enjoy views from **Kiyomizu Temple** and a **Traditional Maiko Performance (Optional: C100.00 per person)** at Gion Corner, ending with a **Western Dinner**. (B / L / WD)

Day 8 / Mar 10 - Kyoto ~ Nara ~ Kobe

After breakfast, take a short ride to Nara, visit **Todaiji Temple** and **Nara Deer Park**, then explore the traditional streets of **Naramachi**. After lunch, head to Kobe for a tour and **sake tasting at the Hakutsuru Sake Brewery Museum**. Dinner is at your arrangement. (B / L)

Day 9 / Mar 11 - Kobe ~ Hiroshima ~ Kobe

Board the **Shinkansen (bullet train)** to **Hiroshima** in the morning to visit the **Peace Memorial Park and Museum**. Then take a ferry to **Miyajima Island** to explore **Itsukushima Shrine and the floating torii gate**. Return to Kobe by bullet Train in the late afternoon. (B)

Day 10 / Mar 12 - Kobe ~ Osaka ~ Kobe

Start the day at **Kobe Harbourland** and enjoy views from the **Port Tower Observation Deck**. After a Western lunch, head to Osaka for the **Cup Noodles Museum** and explore **Dotonbori District** for shopping and street food sampling. Return to Kobe in the evening for a **Farewell Dinner featuring renowned Kobe Beef**. (B / L / SD)

Day 11 / Mar 13 - Kobe ~ Osaka / Busan (Korea) (By Air)

After breakfast, transfer to Osaka Kansai International Airport for your flight to Busan. Meet your local guide and visit **Oryukdo Skywalk** for panoramic sea views, then explore **Taejongdae Cliff**. Continue to **Busan International Film Festival Square** and the biggest Fish Market, **Jagalchi Fish Market**. End the day with a delightful **Hanjeongsik Welcome Dinner** featuring Beef Bulgogi, grilled fish. (B / L / SD)

Hotel: Busan ASTI Hotel or similar (4-star)

Day 12 / Mar 14 - Busan

Today, explore **Gamcheon Culture Village, Haedong Yonggungsa Temple** and the **Cheongsapo Red and White Lighthouse**, followed by a **Seafood Steamboat lunch**. Then walk along Busan's famous **Haundae Beach** and get a ride on **Haundae Coastal Train**. End the day with a local **Korean dinner**. (B / L / D)

Day 13 / Mar 15 - Busan ~ Gyeongju

After breakfast, drive to Gyeongju. Today, visit 2 UNESCO Heritage sites – **Seokguram Grotto** and **Bulguksa Temple**, then enjoy a **Ginseng Chicken Soup lunch**. In the afternoon, visit **Cheomsongdae Observatory, Daerungwon Tomb Complex**, and **Gyeongju National Museum**. End with a **Buffet Dinner at Ashley Restaurant**. (B / L / SD)

Hotel: Gyeongju Commodore Hotel or similar (4-Star)

Day 14 / Mar 16 - Gyeongju ~ Seoul

After breakfast, drive to Seoul. Upon arrival, have **Chicken Dakgalbi** for lunch, a stir-fried chicken dish topped with cheese and served with fried rice. Visit **Gyeongbokgung Palace** where you can **dress in traditional Hanbok**. Then, explore the **National Folk Museum** and **Bukchon Hanok Village**. Enjoy **The Painters show (or Nanta)** and explore **Dongdaemun-gu**. Dinner is at your arrangement. (B / L)

Hotel: Four Points by Sheraton Seoul, Guro or similar (4-Star)

Day 15 / Mar 17 - Seoul

This morning, visit the **DMZ Area** in the morning to experience the **Third Tunnel** and learn about the world's most famous divided border. Enjoy a western lunch, then visit the **War Memorial of Korea** and **Insadong**. Enjoy a **Special Farewell Korean Hotpot dinner** and explore **Myeongdong Night Market** before going back to the hotel. (B / L / SD)

Day 16 / Mar 18 - Seoul / Hometown (By Air)

After breakfast, visit **N Seoul Tower** (observatory not included) and shop for souvenirs at a **Local Products Store**. After lunch, transfer to Incheon International Airport for your Air Canada flight back to Vancouver or connection to your hometown.
