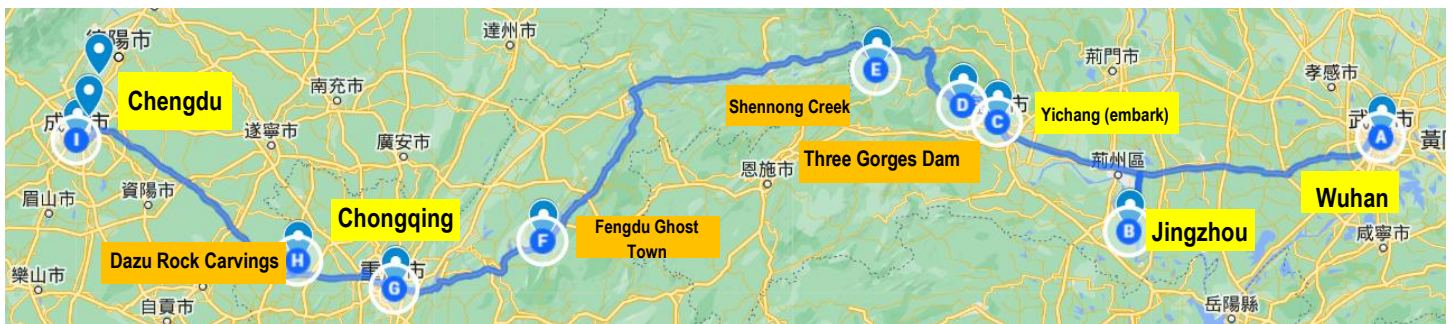

| Day 1 (Sun) | <p>Shenzhen</p> <p>Arrive in Shenzhen on your own and check into the hotel.</p> <p>Overnight: Hotel: Best Western Premier Shenzhen Felicity Hotel (4 star) or similar</p> |
| Day 2 (Mon) | <p>Shenzhen – Wuhan 【By High-speed train】 </p> <p>After breakfast, transfer to Shenzhen High-speed Railway Station. Take the high-speed rail from Shenzhen to Wuhan. (Lunch on own arrangement on high-speed rail)</p> <p>Reference train schedule: Shenzhen/Wuhan G874 1010/1425</p> <p>After arriving in Wuhan, visit the Yellow Crane Tower, the first of the three famous towers in the south of the Yangtze River. The Yellow Crane Tower is located on the Sheshan Mountain in Wuchang. It was first built in the second year of Wu Huangwu (223 AD) in the Three Kingdoms period. It has a history of more than 1,780 years and is a national 5A-level scenic spot. (B / D)</p> <p>Overnight: Wuhan Furama Shanshui Hotel (4 star) or similar</p> |
| Day 3 (Tue) | <p>Wuhan – Jingzhou – Yichang - Yangtze Three Gorges (MV Century Oasis) </p> <p>After breakfast, go to Jingzhou and visit, known as Jiangling City in ancient times. It is one of the important birthplaces of Chu and Three Kingdoms cultures and one of the four most complete ancient city walls in China. Visit the Jingzhou Museum, which currently houses more than 130,000 cultural relics, most of which are unearthed cultural relics from archaeological excavations, and a few are handed down cultural relics and revolutionary cultural relics. Continue to Yichang Maoping Pier to board the Century Cruise luxury cruise ship. Dinner at the cruise ship restaurant. (B / L / D)</p> <p>Overnight: Century Oasis 5-star cruise ship (balcony cabin)</p> |
| Day 4 (Wed) | <p>Three Gorges Tour </p> <p>Go ashore and visit the Three Gorges Dam. The Three Gorges Dam is the largest water conservancy project in the world today, with a total length of 2,335 meters, a crest height of 185 meters, and a total storage capacity of 39.3 billion cubic meters. The five-level ship lock can pass through a 10,000-ton fleet, and the dam's navigation structure can quickly pass through a 3,000-ton passenger and cargo ship. Visit the Three Gorges Project Museum and the Three Gorges Interception Memorial Park to learn more about the history of the Three Gorges Project. Attend the captain's welcome party in the evening. (B / L / D)</p> <p>Overnight: Century Oasis 5-star cruise ship (balcony cabin)</p> |
| Day 5 (Thu) | <p>Three Gorges Tour </p> <p>After breakfast, visit Shennong Creek, locally known as "Beauty Creek", which is 15 kilometers long and has 10 kilometers of original valley. The boat passes through the Wu Gorge, located between Wushan County in Chongqing and Badong County in Hubei Province. The whole length is full of abrupt peaks, beautiful and deep. Wu Gorge is divided into two sections: the Golden Helmet and Silver Armor Gorge, the Arrow Gorge, the Iron Coffin Gorge, and the Menfan Gorge. In the afternoon, the boat passes through Qutang Gorge, which is the starting point of the Three Gorges of the Yangtze River. It reaches Baidi City in Fengjie County in the west and Daxi Town in Wushan County in the east. At Kuimen at the west end of Qutang Gorge, the narrow part of the two mountains is less than 100 meters, which is one of the 10-yuan patterns. Watch the theatrical performance on the boat in the evening. (B / L / D)</p> <p>Overnight: Century Oasis 5-star cruise ship</p> |

| Day 6 (Fri) | <p data-bbox="311 142 1524 178">Three Gorges Tour </p> <p data-bbox="311 191 1524 401">Go ashore and visit Fengdu Ghost Town. It was known as the "Bazi Biedu" in ancient times. It was established as a county in the second year of Emperor Yongyuan of the Eastern Han Dynasty. It has a history of nearly 2,000 years. It is located on the north bank of the Yangtze River in Fengdu County, downstream of Chongqing City, across the river from Fengdu New County. Watch the cultural performance on board in the evening. (B / L / D)</p> <p data-bbox="311 411 824 447">Overnight: Century Oasis 5-star cruise ship</p> |
| Day 7 (Sat) | <p data-bbox="311 447 1524 499">Arrive Chongqing </p> <p data-bbox="311 510 1524 898">Disembark at Chongqing Pier, we set off to People's Square to admire the Great Hall of the People, known as "Little Tiananmen", and then visit the China Three Gorges Museum, which displays the historical, cultural heritage and environment of Chongqing and the Three Gorges area. Next, visit Hongya Cave, which has a history of more than 2,300 years. It is located in the core business district of Chongqing and is famous for its "Hanging Building" architectural style with traditional Bayu architectural characteristics. Stroll around Jiefang Monument and explore downtown Chongqing. In the afternoon, go to Ciqikou Ancient Town (Porcelain Port), a thousand-year-old town famous in Bashu, to taste the antique stone roads, specialty products and local delicacies. Enjoy Chongqing hot pot for dinner. (B / L / D)</p> <p data-bbox="311 909 943 940">Overnight: Chongqing Hilton Hotel (5-star) or similar</p> |
| Day 8 (Sun) | <p data-bbox="311 940 1524 993">Chongqing (full day tour) </p> <p data-bbox="311 1003 1524 1213">After breakfast, visit Danzishi Old Street and overlook Chongqing's landmark building, Raffles City. Then go to the Yangtze River Cableway (one-way), known as the first air corridor of the Yangtze River, and then board the Chongqing Eye to get a bird's eye view of Chongqing. In the afternoon, visit Huguang Guild Hall, Eling Park and No. 2 Factory Cultural and Creative Park. Go to the Liziba viewing platform and watch the light rail pass through the building. (B / L / D)</p> <p data-bbox="311 1224 943 1255">Overnight: Chongqing Hilton Hotel (5-star) or similar</p> |
| Day 9 (Mon) | <p data-bbox="311 1255 1524 1308">Chongqing ~ Dazu Rock Carvings ~ Chengdu </p> <p data-bbox="311 1318 1524 1707">After breakfast, visit Dazu Rock Carvings, a religious stone carving world cultural heritage from the late Tang and early Song Dynasty. With Buddhist themes, the cliff statues on Beishan and Baoding Mountains are the most famous, famous for their grand scale, exquisite carvings and rich themes. It concentratedly displays the essence of the sculpture art of China's "three religions" of Buddhism, Taoism and Confucianism, and is a treasure of Chinese grotto art. Later, we went to Chengdu to visit Kuanzhai Alley (Wide and Narrow Alley), which consists of Kuan (Wide) Alley, Zhai (Narrow) Alley and Jing (Well-shaped) Alley arranged in parallel. They are all antique courtyard houses, retaining the style of the ancient streets of the Qing Dynasty. Together with Daci Temple and Wenshu Monastery, they are known as one of the three protected historical and cultural city blocks in Chengdu. | Day 10 (Tue) | <p data-bbox="313 163 1520 201">Chengdu (full day tour) </p> <p data-bbox="313 212 1520 596">Today, visit the Giant Panda Breeding Research Base, 10 kilometers away from the city center. It is a world-famous important base for the protection, breeding and research of giant pandas. It covers an area of 1,000 acres to protect and breed giant pandas, red pandas, etc. China is famous for its unique and endangered wildlife. In the afternoon, visit the Wuhou Temple, which was built during the Shu-Han Dynasty. It is a famous cultural monument. It was originally a special temple to commemorate Zhuge Liang. It is also known as Kongming Temple, Zhuge Temple, Prime Minister Temple, etc., and then stroll around Jinli Ancient Street, which is the oldest and oldest temple in the history of Western Shu. One of the streets with the most commercial atmosphere, it was famous throughout the country as early as the Qin, Han and Three Kingdoms periods. | Day 11 (Wed) | <p data-bbox="313 657 1520 695">Chengdu (Sanxingdui Museum) </p> <p data-bbox="313 705 1520 999">After breakfast, proceed to visit the Sanxingdui Museum, which is a modern thematic site museum in China. It is a Bronze Age site in southwest China. Two large sacrificial pits from the Shang Dynasty were discovered, and thousands of rare treasures were revealed: the bronze sacred tree, golden staffs, large bronze statues, etc. are among the best in the world. At the same time, the discovery of Sanxingdui also pushed the history of ancient Shu to 5,000 years ago. It is one of the cultural relic groups with the most historical, scientific, cultural and artistic value and the most ornamental value.
