



Korea & Hong Kong 15 Days (13 Nights) Package Tour (KHKG)

Jeju Island, Busan, Gyeongju, Seoul, Hong Kong, Macau

Day 1 - Hometown / Seoul (Korea) (By Air)

Today, take your flight to Seoul. Please inquire with your travel agent about the international air ticket.

Day 2 - Arrive Seoul

Cross the International Date Line to Seoul. Upon arrival, you will be met at the airport and transferred to the hotel.

Hotel: Seoul Myeongdong Splaisir Hotel or similar (4-Star)

Day 3 - Seoul (Free Day)

After breakfast, explore the area on your own leisure. (B)

Day 4 - Seoul ~ Jeju Island (By Air)

This morning, travel to Gimpo International Airport for your flight to Jeju Island. Upon arrival at Jeju International Airport, begin your adventure by visiting Yongduam Rock, a striking dragon-shaped rock formation created by strong winds and waves. Next, explore the Jeju National Museum, where you'll discover the island's rich history and cultural heritage through fascinating exhibits and artifacts. Afterwards, immerse yourself in the vibrant local atmosphere at Dongmun Traditional Market, where you can sample fresh seafood, purchase unique souvenirs, and experience authentic island life. Finally, head to your hotel Day 12 - Hong Kong for check-in and some well-deserved relaxation. (B)

Hotel: Jeju Ramada City Hall Hotel or similar (4-Star)

Day 5 - Jeiu Island

Start your day with a delicious hotel breakfast . Your first stop is Seongsan Sunrise Peak, a UNESCO World Heritage site known for its spectacular views and volcanic crater. Next, visit the picturesque Seopjikoji Seaside, where the rugged coastline and serene ocean views offer a tranquil experience. Continue your journey to **Seongeup Folk Village**, a well-preserved traditional village that showcases the unique lifestyle and architecture of Jeju's past. In the afternoon, head to Sanbangsan Mountain, a majestic volcanic formation with a temple Taipa Ferry Terminal. Upon arrival around noon, meet your Macau tour guide and nestled in its cliffs and panoramic views of the island. Conclude your day with a visit to Yacheonsa Temple, one of the largest Buddhist temples in Korea. (B)

Day 6 - Jeju Island ~ Busan (By Air)

After breakfast, travel to Jeju International Airport for your flight to Busan. Meet your local guide and visit Oryukdo Skywalk for panoramic sea views, then explore Taejongdae Cliff. Continue to Busan International Film Festival Square and the biggest Fish Market, Jagalchi Fish Market. End the day with a delightful Hanjeongsik Welcome Dinner featuring Beef Bulgogi and grilled fish. (B / L / SD) Hotel: Busan ASTI Hotel or similar (4-star)

Today, explore Gamcheon Culture Village, Haedong Yonggungsa Temple and the Cheongsapo Red and White Lighthouse, followed by a Seafood Steamboat lunch. Then walk along Busan's famous Haeundae Beach and get a ride on Haeundae Coastal Train. End the day with a local Korean dinner. (B / L / D)

Day 8 - Busan ~ Gyeongju

After breakfast, drive to Gyeongju. Today, visit 2 UNESCO Heritage sites -Seokguram Grotto and Bulguksa Temple, then enjoy a Ginseng Chicken Soup lunch. In the afternoon, visit Cheomsongdae Observatory, Daerungwon Tomb Complex, and Gyeongju National Museum. End with a Buffet Dinner at Ashley Restaurant. (B / L / SD)

Hotel: Gyeongju Commodore Hotel or similar (4-Star)

Day 9 - Gyeongju ~ Seoul

After breakfast, drive to Seoul. Upon arrival, have Chicken Dakgalbi for lunch, a stir-fried chicken dish topped with cheese and served with fried rice. Visit Gyeongbokgung Palace where you can dress in traditional Hanbok. Then, explore the National Folk Museum and Bukchon Hanok Village. Enjoy The Painters show (or Nanta) and explore Dongdaemun-gu. Dinner is at your arrangement. (B / L) Hotel: Four Points by Sheraton Seoul, Guro or similar (4-Star)

Day 10 - Seoul

This morning, visit the DMZ Area in the morning to experience the Third Tunnel and learn about the world's most famous divided border. Enjoy a Western lunch, then visit the War Memorial of Korea and Insadong. Then a Special Farewell Dinner after visiting Myeongdong Night Market and N Seoul Tower (No observatory). (B / L / SD)

Day 11 - Seoul / Hong Kong (By Air)

After breakfast, transfer to Incheon International Airport for your flight to Hong Kong. Upon arrival, be greeted and transferred to the hotel. (B) Hotel: Harbour Plaza Metropolis (4-Star)

Start your day with a 9 AM pickup from your hotel, followed by a scenic ride on the Peak Tram to the top of Victoria Peak, where you'll enjoy breathtaking views of Hong Kong. Next, visit Bauhinia Square, an iconic symbol of the city, before taking a relaxing Star Ferry harbour cruise across Victoria Harbour. Continue to the Avenue of Stars and the historic Clock Tower for some sightseeing along the waterfront. Around 1 PM, indulge in a delicious dim sum lunch, before being dropped off at your hotel by 2 PM to conclude your tour. (B/L)

After breakfast, catch a ferry around 10 or 10:30 AM from Hong Kong to Macau's start your adventure by visiting historic sites such as St. Paul's Cathedral, the Old City Walls, and the serene A-Ma Temple. Enjoy some free time for lunch on your own before continuing the tour with a stroll down Lovers Lane, a visit to Golden Lotus Square, and a photo stop at the Macau Tower, passing by the Koulum Statue along the way. At 4 PM, return to the Taipa Ferry Terminal for your ferry back to Hong Kong. Arrive at the Hong Kong Pier by 6 PM, with a transfer to your hotel by 7:15 PM to conclude your day. (B/L)

Day 14 - Hong Kong (Free Day)

After breakfast, explore the area on your own leisure. (B)

Day 15 - Hong Kong / Hometown (By Air)

Following breakfast, be transferred to Hong Kong International Airport for your flight back to your hometown (B).
