

CANCELLATION PENALTIES

All cancellations must be made in writing to Asia Sky Holidays (referred to herein as "Asia Sky") by the booking agent. Penalties for any cancellation are to be assessed according to the date of receipt of such cancellation as follows:

- After the booking has been confirmed: A deposit of C\$400.00 per person is non-refundable
 59 to 45 days prior to departure: 60% of the tour price per person is
- 59 to 45 days prior to departure: 60% of the tour price per person in non-refundable
- 44 to 30 days prior to departure: 80% of the tour price per person is non-refundable
 70 to 15 departure: 90% of the tour price per person is
- 29 to 15 days prior to departure: 90% of the tour price per person is non-refundable
- 14 days or less prior to departure: 100% of the tour price is nonrefundable

REFUNDS

No refunds will be made once the tour has commenced. All unused services or tour arrangements, domestic and international flights, ground transportation and hotel accommodations, sightseeing tours, and special features are non-refundable.

TOUR PRICE

Tour price includes air transportation and land arrangements as detailed in the package.
