













Day 1 / Oct 20 - Vancouver / Beijing (China) (YVR/PEK CA992 1210/1625+1)

Fly from Vancouver by Air China flight to Beijing.

Day 2 / Oct 21 - Arrive in Beijing

Arrive in Beijing, the capital city of China. You will be greeted by your local guide and transferred to your hotel. Relax or explore Beijing at your leisure.

Hotel: Lake View Hotel (5-Star)

Day 3 / Oct 22 - Beijing

Start the day at *Tian'anmen Square*, then delve into the majestic *Forbidden City*. Explore the *Wangfujing shopping area* and the historic Chinese medicine center, "*Tong Ren Tang*". Tonight, enjoy a *Welcome Peking Duck Dinner*. (B / L / SD)

Day 4 / Oct 23 - Beijing

Spend an inspiring day at the *Great Wall (Juyong Pass)*. Then tour around the *Summer Palace* for an enchanting panorama of lake, landscape, pagodas, and pavilions. On the way back, have a closer look at the *2008 Beijing Olympic Stadium (the Bird's Nest & the Water Cube)*. Enjoy a dazzling *Beijing Acrobatic Show* in the evening. (B / L / D)

Day 5 / Oct 24 - Beijing (Free Day)

Today is free for you to explore Beijing. Lunch and dinner are on your own. (B)

Day 6 / Oct 25 - Beijing ~ Xi'an (By High Speed Train G57 1405/1830)

This morning, take a *Rickshaw Tour* around the ancient alleyways of *Hutong* - one of Beijing's 700-year-old traditional cottage neighborhoods. You can visit a family in one of the "*Quadrangles*". After lunch, you will have a very special experience on *China High-Speed Train* from Beijing to Xi'an. Dinner on your own on the train.

Hotel: Swisstouches Hotel Xi'an (5-star)

Day 7 / Oct 26 - Xi'an

Visit the historic *Little Goose Pagoda* and *Big Goose Pagoda Square*, followed by a tour of the ancient *Xian City Wall*. Enjoy lunch at *Muslin Quarter Street*, renowned for its local delicacies. *Xi'an Night Tour* after dinner. (B / L / WD)

Day 8 / Oct 27 - Xi'an

Visit the *Terra-cotta Warriors and Horses excavation site* and enjoy a *noodle-making show and Handmade Noodle lunch*. In the evening, enjoy the *Xi'an Special Dumpling Banquet alongside the Tang Dynasty Show*. (B / L / SD)

Day 9 / Oct 28 - Xi'an / Lhasa (By Air)

Today, fly to Lhasa to begin the adventure in *Tibetan Plateau*, see the spectacular views of 22,000-foot Himalayan peaks. Upon arrival, relax and adjust to being 12,000 feet above sea level. (B)

Hotel: Lhasa Hotel VIP Building (5-Star)

Day 10 / Oct 29 - Lhasa

Spend a full day exploring the mysteries of this sacred land at the "roof of the world". You'll visit **Potala Palace**, a towering 1,000 room structure and former living quarters of the Dalai Lama. Then, visit **Lhasa's Summer Palace**, **Luobulinka and Jokhang Temple**, Tibet's oldest and most holy spiritual center located in the city core. You will explore the **Bakor Street** yourself . (B / L / D)

Day 11 / Oct 30 - Lhasa ~ Gyantse ~ Shigatse

A spectacular drive along an old caravan trade route takes you through stunning glacial landscapes and high mountain passes to Gyantse via *Yamdroktso Lake*. In Gyantse, tourists will visit the famous *Pelkor Monastery*. (B / L / D)

Hotel: Hilton Shigatse (5-Star)

Day 12 / Oct 31 - Shigatse ~ Lhasa

The highlight of your full day exploration of Shigatse will begin with a tour to *Tashilhunpo Monastery*, one of the most exquisite in Tibet and the former seat of the Panchen Lama. Fabulous murals grace the inner walls of this elaborate temple complex - but the focal point is an enormous bronze *Buddha*, the largest in Tibet, which stands 86 feet high and contains over 600 pounds of pure gold. (B / L / D)

Day 13 / Nov 01 - Lhasa / Chongqing (By Air)

Take a morning flight to Chongqing. You will have a city tour starting with a visit to the *Chongqing Zoo* to see Pandas and the Huguang Guild Hall. Indulge in a special *Sichuan-style lunch*. Enjoy a free afternoon or an optional tour to enjoy the fantastic *Chongqing by Night with Hot Pot Dinner*. (US\$50.00 pp, pay locally). (B / L) *Hotel: Chongqing Hilton Hotel (5-Star)*

Day 14 / Nov 02 - Chongqing ~ Dazu ~ Chongqing

After breakfast, drive to Dazu County (2 hrs) to visit the UNESCOlisted *Baodingshan Rock Carvings*, renowned for their scale and artistry. Return to the hotel via *Ciqikou Ancient Town* to explore traditional architecture, enjoy local snacks, and see the *Liziba monorail* passing through a building. (B / L / D)

Day 15 / Nov 03 - Chongqing / Shanghai ~ Zhujiajiao ~ Suzhou (By Air)

Take a flight to Shanghai. Take an excursion to **Zhujiajiao (Water Village)** and take a ride to **Suzhou**, a city famous for its canals, stone bridges, and pagodas. (B / D)

Hotel: Wyndham Garden Suzhou (5-Star)

Day 16 / Nov 04 - Suzhou

Explore **Suzhou Museum**, **Lingering Garden** (a UNESCO World Heritage Site), and historic **Pingjiang Road**. Tonight, enjoy the **China Farewell Dinner**. (B / L / SD)

Day 17 / Nov 05 - Suzhou ~ Shanghai

After breakfast, return to Shanghai. You will visit the *Xin Tian Di*, *Shanghai Museum*, *People's Square*, the "Bund", and *Yuyuan Bazaar*. Then visit *Pudong Development Zone*, *Oriental Pearl TV Tower*, and the *Nanjing Road Shopping Street*. The *Huangpu River Night Cruise* could be arranged as an optional tour at night. (US\$50.00 pp pay locally). (B/L/D)

Hotel: Shanghai Jeurong Hotel (5-Star)

Day 18 / Nov 06 - Shanghai (Free Day)

Today is free for you to explore Shanghai. Lunch and dinner on your own. (B)

Day 19 / Nov 07 - Shanghai / Vancouver (via Beijing) (SHA/PEK CA1590 0855/1115) (PEK/YVR CA997 1420/1000)

After breakfast, transfer to the Shanghai Airport to depart for Vancouver, and arrive home on the same day. (B)
